

NHAVA SHEVA INTERNATIONAL CONTAINER TERMINAL STRENGTHENS CONNECTIVITY TO CHINA AND SINGAPORE WITH NEW WEEKLY SERVICE – AS3

Mumbai, India, 03 May 2018: Global trade enabler DP World operated Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal (NSICT) hosted the maiden call of APL's new weekly service – Asia Subcontinent Express 3 (AS3). The first vessel to call under AS3 service was APL Japan.

This service strengthens India's connectivity to China and Singapore. The service will be deploying vessels of more than 5000 TEU capacity and will follow the below port rotations: Shanghai – Ningbo – Xiamen – Singapore – Nhava Sheva – Karachi – Shanghai
