Sub : Repairs to road and drains at South Gate Complex

Sir,

It is observed that surface drainage system in and around South Gate Complex is totally choked and not functional. Because of this, water stagnates in gate lanes and road are also damaged badly. PP&D Department has taken up the work of modification of drainage system and construction of concrete pavement at South Gate Complex, where water stagnation is observed and road pavement is damaged. While taking up the said work, traffic movement at South Gate will be affected and hence, a site meeting was conducted with CISF authorities and all stakeholders of the Port.

It has been decided to take up the work in phases so as to least hamper the traffic movement at South Gate and the following traffic arrangements has been finalized.

- 1 . Traffic entering the port will continue as per the existing arrangements from South Gate Complex and Central Gate Complex.
2. IT RHO movement will continue to enter and exit from ODC Gate at South Gate Complex.
3. Over Dimensional Cargo (ODC), vehicles carrying construction debris for disposal outside custom bound area, cement carriers etc. will enter and exit from North Gate Complex.


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4. Light Motor vehicles, pass holders and vehicle not carrying any material will exit from Central Gate Complex at Lane No. 14.
5. Pedestrians and vehicles carrying material shall exit from Central Gate Complex Lane No. 13.

All out efforts will be made to complete the subject work at the earliest. However, considering the forthcoming monsoon, it is expected that the work will be completed within two month's period.

The said arrangements will be effective from 19th May, 2020.
