## **TRADE NOTICE**

### **Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal Private Ltd. (NSICT)**

Dear Valued Customer,

This is in reference to the global crisis created by COVID 19. All Port related activities have been declared as Essential services by the Govt of India. Despite various operational challenges and breakdown in the logistic chain , Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal Private Limited (NSICT) has continued to operate through the lockdown period and have done everything to maintain the best possible service levels whilst maintaining the highest level of safety, health and security for our customers, vendors, employees and the communities where we operate.

Based on the circular No.PD-14033/4/2020-PD VII dated 21.04.2020 issued by the Ministry of Shipping, for the lock down period ie 22.03.2020 to 3.05.2020 ,NSICT shall not levy

- a) Storage charges on all import/ export containers moved by road and rail (CFS/ DPD/ Empty/ICD)
- b) Change of status of container from Rail to Road or vice-versa

Further from 13.04.2020 to 03.05.2020

- (a) no shifting charges will be levied for DPD-DPD containers moved by Rail after 48 hours to ICDs Mulund & Tarapur as they are declared as 'extended port gates' of JNPT.

We urge the trade to intensify their efforts to evacuate containers as soon as possible, to ensure sufficient space at the terminal to maintain productivity levels and continued handling of vessels.
