Subject: Annual Escalation factor for ARR computation and computation of indexed SOR by BOT operators governed under Tariff Guidelines,2019 and previously governed by erstwhile Tariff Guidelines 2005.

Sir,

As per the clauses 2.8 and 2.12 of the Tariff Policy, 2019, the Authority is required to announce the indexation factor considering the WPI occurring between 1 January 2019 and 1 January of the relevant year i.e. 1 January 2020 so as to enable the BOT operators governed under the Tariff Guidelines 2019 and previously governed by the Tariff Guidelines 2005 for computation of indexed ARR and to draw the indexed SOR to be applicable during the year 2020-21.

2. The WPI occurring between the relevant dates was ascertained from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. Considering variation in WPI occurring between 1 January 2019 and 1 January 2020, the Authority has approved the following:

(i). Annual indexation of 1.88% (at 100% of the WPI variation) for computation of indexed ARR as per Clause 2.8. of the Tariff Guidelines 2019 for tariff revision proposal filed in year 2020-21.

(ii). Annual indexation of 1.13% (at 60% of the WPI variation)for indexation of SOR to arrive at the indexed SOR by BOT operators as per Clause 2.12. of the Tariff Guidelines 2019. The indexed SOR shall be effective from 1 May 2020 and shall be valid till 30 April 2021.

3. The BOT operators may, therefore, take appropriate action accordingly.

4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
